Reflection on Pastor Doug's Sermon: "Gifts of the Spirit"

- Speaking in Tongues: Expressing prayer or praise in languages unknown to the speaker, as inspired by the Holy Spirit.
- · Interpretation of Tongues: Translating messages spoken in tongues so that the whole group may benefit from the message.
- Teaching: Explaining and applying spiritual truths, helping others to understand and grow in faith.
- · Wisdom: Offering insight and guidance to help others navigate life's challenges.
